Doctrinal Statement



We believe:

- A. In the verbal and plenary inspiration of the Bible, and that it is inerrant in its original autographs. It is the only and sufficient authority for all matters of faith and practice. (Luke 21:33; John 16:13-15; 17:17; 2 Timothy 3:15-17; Hebrews 4:12; 2 Peter 1:19-21)
- B. In one God eternally existing in three equal Persons Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Genesis 1:1-2; Psalm 110:1; Matthew 3:16-17; 28:19; Luke 1:35; John 1:1, 14; 10:30; Acts 5:3; 2 Corinthians 13:14; Colossians 1:15-17; 1 Peter 1:1-2)
- C. In Jesus Christ, true God and true man, the Creator and Sustainer of the universe, His virgin birth, His sacrificial death, His bodily resurrection from the dead, His ascension into Heaven, His present work of intercession with the Father on behalf of believers, His imminent return to receive His church, to establish His kingdom and eventually to judge the world.
